The BBC's Civil War Over Gaza

The BBC is facing an internal revolt over its reporting on Israel's war on Gaza. Their primary battlefield has become the online news operation. Drop Site News spoke to 13 current and former staffers who mapped out the extensive bias in the BBC's coverage and how their demands for change have been largely met with silence from management. ...the coverage has devalued Palestinian life, ignored atrocities, and created a false equivalence in an entirely unbalanced conflict.

The BBC journalists who spoke to Drop Site News believe the imbalance is structural, and has been enforced by the top brass for many years ... The journalists also overwhelmingly point to the role of one person in particular: Raffi Berg, BBC News online's Middle East editor. Berg sets the tone for the BBC's digital output on Israel and Palestine, they say. They also allege that internal complaints about how the BBC covers Gaza have been repeatedly brushed aside. "This guy's entire job is to water down everything that's too critical of Israel," one former BBC journalist said.

According to Al Jazeera's 2017 documentary *The Lobby USA*, The Israeli government has launched a covert campaign to gather information on American citizens.

Sima Vaknin-Gil: Director General of Israel's Ministry of Strategic Affairs and Public Diplomacy: "We have three different sub campaigns: data Gathering, working on activist organization, money Trail." ... "This is something that only a country with its resources can do the best. We have FDD. We have others working on this."

Think tanks like the FDD play an important role for Israel in the media. Their selective use of evidence is often presented as legitimate academic research. Mearsheimer notes: "They try to educate people to understand that Israel is effectively a western liberal democracy in the sea of terrorist states, which is the Arab world. The other goal is to intimidate and to smear people."

Jonathan Schanzer works for the FDD. He produces research on financing of armed groups. Schanzer is invited by pro-Israel congressmen to provide evidence before subcommittees on terrorism and the middle east. He uses them to insinuate that prominent activists for Palestinian equal rights are linked to armed groups. Schanzer: "The AMP's (American Muslims for Palestine) founder and president Hatem Bazian was one of two featured speakers at a 2004 fundraising dinner in California. Incidentally the other speaker at this dinner was Mohammed Almezan(?) who's currently in jail for his role in the Holy Land Foundation and for providing financial support to Hamas.

Hatem Bazian, Chairman of American Muslims for Palestine observed "When you enter into the congressional record, now people begin to think that there's some legitimacy to it, so this dumping of utter nonsense and garbage into the congressional record, into a legitimate hearing, will have an effect down the line.

Schanzer's allegations that American students are somehow connected to armed groups in the middle east has become part of the lobby's attempt to demonize the Boycott Divest and Sanction (BDS) movement.

Western media enabling Gaza genocide

Writers Against the War on Gaza Lays Out New York Times’s Ties to Israeli Occupation, Gaza Genocide Headline Jul 17, 2025

A group called Writers Against the War on Gaza has published a dossier accusing The New York Times of pro-Israel, anti-Palestinian bias. The coalition’s research builds on decades of analyses showing how many high-ranking New York Times editors, journalists and executive officers hold material and ideological ties to Israeli occupation and apartheid; they also report Times editors have ordered reporters to avoid so-called inflammatory terms including “genocide,” “ethnic cleansing” and “occupied territory” — and even to avoid saying “Palestine.”

Writers group accuses New York Times of being 'accomplice to the genocide in Gaza' July 18 2025

A new [dossier](#) released by a coalition of media workers has accused The New York Times of systemic pro-[Israel](#) and anti-[Palestinian](#) bias, and alleged that nearly two dozen of its top journalists, editors and executives have extensive ties to pro-Israel lobbying groups.

"The New York Times is an accomplice to the genocide in Gaza, serving as a mouthpiece for American imperialism and shaping elite consensus around foreign policy," a statement from the group Writers Against the War on Gaza (Wawog) reads.

Like several mainstream news outlets, the NYT has come under intense scrutiny over its reporting of the war on Gaza, with several human rights activists and analysts accusing the publication of providing cover for Israeli war crimes.

NYT Suppressed Genocide Discussion When It Could Have Made a Difference

More than a year ago, the **Intercept** ([4/15/24](#)) reported on a leaked internal **New York Times** memo from the newspaper's management, telling its reporters covering Gaza to "restrict the use of the terms 'genocide' and 'ethnic cleansing.'" About "genocide" specifically, the memo decreed, "We should...set a high bar for allowing others to use it as an accusation, whether in quotations or not."

The American Friends Service Committee ([1/8/25](#)), a Quaker organization, said it had "canceled planned advertising with the **New York Times** after the paper refused to allow an ad that referred to Israel's genocide in Gaza."

Western media enabling Gaza genocide and rewriting history, say experts

June 29 2025

As [Israel's](#) war on [Gaza](#) intensifies and expands across the Middle East, media analysts and human rights advocates are raising concerns over the lack of international accountability and the role of western news outlets in shaping public perception of the conflict.

At a panel hosted by the International Centre of Justice for Palestinians (ICJP) in London on Saturday, experts accused mainstream Western media of contributing to the denial and distortion of atrocities unfolding in Gaza.

[The Centre for Media Monitoring \(CFMM\)](#) presented findings highlighting how often leading media organization's downplay or dismiss claims of genocide. Faisal Hanif, a media analyst at CFMM, said the BBC had shut down references to genocide in its Gaza coverage more than 100 times over the past year.

We Analyzed Thousands of News Articles: Here's the Proof of Pro-Israel Bias in Mainstream Media

Ask anyone who has followed news about Gaza with even a smidgen of critical thinking, and they will tell you: Media organizations are biased against Palestinians — and systematically favor Israel.

It's easy to say but harder to prove. Doing empirical analysis that shows these biases is time-consuming and complex, full of pitfalls and nuances that can muddy the picture. Yet the double standards are everywhere — and there are ways to do sober, qualitative work that elucidates not only the differences in how Israeli and Palestinian life are covered, but also also in how other recent conflicts are covered.
